# Road and railway maintenance in and around Amsterdam

All year round, with a peak between May and October

#### What is the problem?

A lot of roads, railway lines, bridges and tunnels in and around Amsterdam need maintenance work that must be done soon. On top of this, there are big summer events in and around the city that will also cause congestion. The city will thus be even busier between May and the beginning of October, causing extreme transport issues for almost everyone travelling to, from or through Amsterdam.



#### What will be done?

Among the routes that Rijkswaterstaat (the Directorate-General for Public Works and Water Management) will work on are the Ring A10 Oost, the Second Coen Tunnel from Amsterdam West to North, the A1 from the Watergraafsmeer intersection to Diemen, the A4 between the De Hoek intersection and Burgerveen, the A9 between the Badhoevedorp and Holendrecht intersections and the Ring A10 Zuid.

At the same time, the Municipality of Amsterdam will work on the IJ Tunnel, Bijlmerdreef and IJburglaan, and ProRail on Amsterdam Central Station, Amsterdam Zuid station and the Schiphol Tunnel.

In celebration of Amsterdam's 750th anniversary, the municipality will hold the Festival op de Ring in June for which a large section of the A10 will be closed. Further, some sections of motorways will be closed because of the NATO Summit in The Hague. And the SAIL event in August will also bring a lot of visitors to the city.

#### Inconvenience for travellers


Travellers will incur road closures, diversions, more traffic and longer travel times. Almost everyone that travels to, from or through Amsterdam, regardless of their direction of travel, will experience delays. The work on the railways may also lead to longer travel times in public transport.

### Stuck in traffic or adapt to it

We recommend travellers to choose whether and how they travel, and to be well prepared. If possible, work more from home, travel outside rush hour, take a different mode of transport, or car pool.
